<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Yoda</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know the assigned roles of each team member &amp; make sure everyone is completing their jobs.</li> <li>• Know the schedule for the day and keep group on track to be on time to activities.</li> <li>• Ensure “Group Guidelines” are being followed.</li> <li>• Facilitate any group discussions that might occur during the day, including Evening Meetings (w/form).</li> <li>• Hold onto group information such as the schedule, Group Guidelines, Evening Meetings Form, menu, map &amp; compass, equipment inventory. etc.</li> <li>• On Base (CDA) – Sweep CDA and clean tables.</li> <li>• On Base (Bathhouse) – Clean Boys’ bathroom</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Captain Planet(s)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure Leave No Trace ethics are being followed.</li> <li>• When leaving any area (including vans), make sure a sweep of area for trash and gear is completed.</li> <li>• Set up hand washing station at camp and wash bins for meal cleanup.</li> <li>• Carry water purifier and ensure all team members have sufficient water. Call for water breaks to keep team hydrated.</li> <li>• Organize and supervise wood gathering, fire building, fire maintenance, ensure it is put out correctly.</li> <li>• On Base (CDA) – Sweep CDA and clean tables.</li> <li>• On Base (Bathhouse) – clean Girls’ bathroom</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Coach</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know what the day’s activities are &amp; make sure all team members have proper clothing and essentials.</li> <li>• Facilitate sunscreen circles throughout the day &amp; make sure all students are wearing sunscreen.</li> <li>• Carry and display group flag and any team mascot.</li> <li>• Keep up team morale through songs, stories, jokes, dance parties, pleasant conversation, etc. During down times, facilitate games and/or fun activities.</li> <li>• Remind staff to take pictures throughout the day.</li> <li>• On Base (CDA) – Sweep CDA and clean tables.</li> <li>• On Base (Bathhouse) – clean Boys’ bathroom.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Sherpa(s)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make sure the group has the gear they need for each day’s activity.</li> <li>• Clean and store group gear (for example; clean pots and pans after meals).</li> <li>• Keep tents and equipment clean and in good repair.</li> <li>• Make sure the group keeps track of all of its gear. Assist staff with gear distribution and retrieval.</li> <li>• On Base (CDA) – help clean dishes and food.</li> <li>• On Base (Bathhouse) – clean showers</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Chef(s)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make sure that the kitchen circle is established and that no one enters without permission.</li> <li>• Oversee preparation of each meal and serve equal portions to group members.</li> <li>• Put away all leftover food.</li> <li>• Check cooler in the morning and the evening to keep food from becoming water-logged.</li> <li>• On Base (CDA) – help set up &amp; serve meals</li> <li>• On Base (Bathhouse) – clean Girls’ bathroom.</li> </ul>
